barcoo is first German shopping application for Nokia Point & Find

- **barcoo is integrated as first German shopping application for Nokia's mobile service "Point & Find"**

Berlin, September 9, 2009 – **Barcoo is cooperating with Nokia for its new mobile service "Point & Find". The barcode scanner displays product information on the cell phone and is easily usable for German Nokia users.**

Nokia presented its new mobile phone service "Point & Find" at Nokia World in Stuttgart on September 2nd and 3rd. There are various applications integrated in the service that give the user information about objects from the internet after it is recognized using the cell phone's camera. barcoo represents the first German shopping application integrated in Nokia Point & Find's beta service. The software of this Berlin based start-up enables the cell phone camera to scan the barcode on a product. After the product is scanned, information about the product from the mobile internet is automatically shown on the cell phone display in real time. Consumers are then able to access independent information regarding electronics, CD's, DVD's, books and groceries while shopping. Examples of information provided by barcoo include test reports, price comparisons, ecological information as well as user ratings. For groceries the consumers get the traffic light of nutritional values and further information about the product. Many Nokia models additionally show local price comparison and other stores in the area of the user where the product is available. Ethelbert Williams, Head of Marketing at Nokia "Point & Find" says: "The Barcoo shopping application is a perfect showcase of the Nokia Point & Find open platform's ability to connect consumers to innovative content and solutions through the mobile".

No installation of the barcoo application necessary

Until now, users could only install the barcode scanner from www.barcoo.mobi. Nokia phone users can now use barcoo automatically when they install "Point & Find". The service is now available to download free at <http://pointandfind.nokia.com>. Aside from barcoo, another example of an application integrated in the "Point & Find" service gives relevant information regarding photographed points of interest.
